YAF, Local Colleges to Host Free Kids' Events This Winter

(DULUTH, MINN.) --- Registration is now open for the popular Saturday Morning at the Races series, which will again be hosted by the Young Athletes Foundation (YAF) throughout this winter.

The YAF will again partner with three area colleges to host these free kids' events throughout January and February, providing opportunity for our region's children to continue living healthy and active lifestyles even through the year's colder months.

The Saturday Morning at the Races series is free and open to all children ages 14 and under, with adaptive and wheelchair athlete opportunities available at all locations.



Participants, based on age, will have the opportunity to complete either a 1/8-mile, a 1/4-mile, or a 1/2-mile course, and every child will also receive a T-shirt co-branded with that weekend's college partner.

Races will start at 10:00 a.m. each week, and participants will be separated into different heats based on the number of kids in any specific age group.
